Arrangements During Bad Weather

HKPUIC

Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 1 or 3

When Signal No. 1 or 3 is hoisted on a working day, classes will be held as scheduled.

Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or Above – Arrangements for students NOT YET at HKPUIC

- When Signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or an announcement is made by the Hong Kong Observatory that it is likely to be hoisted within the next two hours, at any time between 06:30 and 12:00, all daytime classes (i.e. 08:30 to 18:30) will be cancelled.
- When Signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or an announcement is made by the Hong Kong Observatory that it is likely to be hoisted within the next two hours, at any time between 12:00 and 16:30, all afternoon classes (i.e. 13:30 to 18:30) will be cancelled.

Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or Above – Arrangements for students ALREADY at HKPUIC

When the Hong Kong Observatory announces during office hours after 08:30 that Signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or an announcement is made by the Hong Kong Observatory that it is likely to be hoisted within the next two hours, if you are attending classes, you will be released to go home as soon as possible.

Rainstorm Red Warning

If the Rainstorm Red Warning is issued during working hours, classes will be held as scheduled unless the University announces the suspension of these activities through the radio.

Rainstorm Black Warning – Arrangements for Students NOT YET at HKPUIC

If the Rainstorm Black Warning is issued between 06:30 and 12:00, all day classes between 08:30 and 18:30 will be cancelled.

Rainstorm Black Warning – Arrangements for Students ALREADY at HKPUIC

- As advised by Government, people should take shelter in a safe place during a Rainstorm Black Warning. Therefore, if the Rainstorm Black Warning is issued during office hours, all classes will continue unless otherwise announced by the Academic Secretariat/Center Supervisors.
- If the warning is still in force when classes end, students are advised to stay on campus (in the Shaw Amenities Building) for their own safety until the warning has been cancelled or the traffic conditions have improved. Air-conditioning will be maintained whenever practicable while the warning is current. Students should contact the Campus Security Control Centre at 2766-7666 for assistance where necessary.

HKUST

Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 1 or 3

When Signal No. 1 or 3 is hoisted on a working day, classes will be held as scheduled.

Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above

- When Signal No. 8 or above is hoisted or it is announced by the Hong Kong Observatory that it is likely to be hoisted within 2 hours between 07:00 and 12:00, classes scheduled for 09:00 to 13:00 are cancelled. Classes which are in progress should stop as soon as Signal No. 8 is hoisted. Resumption of class depends on when the Signal is lowered.
- When Signal No. 8 or above is hoisted or it is announced by the Hong Kong Observatory that it is likely to be hoisted within 2 hours between 12:00 and 18:00, classes scheduled for the rest of the day are cancelled as soon as Signal No. 8 is hoisted.
- When Signal No. 8 or above is lowered before 07:00, classes scheduled for 09:00 and onwards will resume as normal.
- When Signal No. 8 or above is lowered between 07:00 and 12:00, classes scheduled for 14:00 and onwards will resume as normal.
- When Signal No. 8 or above is lowered after 12:00, all classes scheduled for the rest of the day will be cancelled.

Rainstorm Red Warning

When the Rainstorm Red Warning is issued during a normal class day, all classes will be conducted as scheduled.

Rainstorm Black Warning

- When the Rainstorm Black Warning is issued or it is announced by the Hong Kong Observatory that it is likely to be issued within 2 hours between 07:00 and 12:00, classes scheduled for 09:00 to 13:00 are cancelled. Classes which are in progress, however, should continue until the end. Staff and students should stay where they are or take shelter in a safe place. In case of class cancellation, resumption of class depends on when the warning is cancelled.
- When the Rainstorm Black Warning is issued or it is announced by the Hong Kong Observatory that it is likely to be issued within 2 hours between 12:00 and 18:00, classes should continue until the end. Staff and students should stay where they are or take shelter in a safe place.
- When the Rainstorm Black Warning is cancelled before 07:00, all classes scheduled for 09:00 and onwards will resume as normal.
- When the Rainstorm Black Warning is cancelled between 07:00 and 12:00, all classes scheduled for 14:00 and onwards will resume as normal.
- When the Rainstorm Black Warning is cancelled after 12:00, all classes scheduled for the rest of the day will be cancelled.
