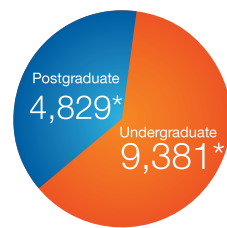

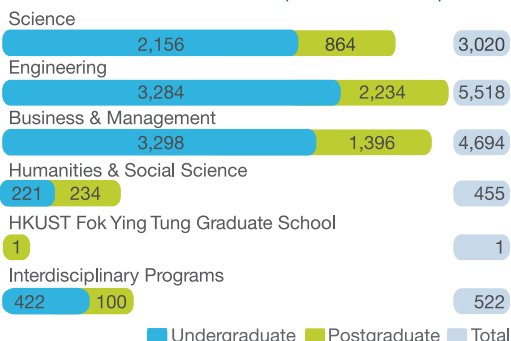

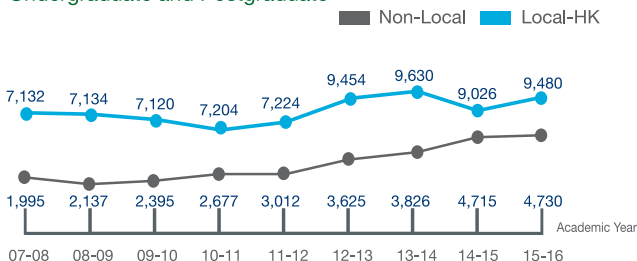


STUDENT NUMBERS (AS AT SEP 2016)
