Faculty Positions

The Division of Humanities of the School of Humanities and Social Science invites applications and nominations for one tenure-track faculty position at senior level (Associate Professor/Professor) in history and three tenure-track faculty positions at all levels (Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor) in literature beginning in Spring or Fall 2010. Appointees would teach graduate courses in their areas of specialization and undergraduate courses in China-related humanistic studies. Applicants should have a PhD and those for senior level position should be scholars with demonstrated academic record. Area of specialties is open but those candidates with specialties in history in late imperial China, Western literary theory in comparative perspective, Chinese classical literature and literary criticism, and contemporary Chinese film and literature are desirable. Interdisciplinary and interregional research orientation is preferred. Candidates interested in women's and gender studies, popular culture, or cultural studies are also encouraged to apply. Review of applications will start on 1 November 2009, and will continue until the positions are filled.

Salary is highly competitive. Fringe benefits include medical/dental benefits and annual leave. Housing will also be provided where applicable. For appointment at Assistant/Associate Professor level, initial appointment will normally be on a three-year contract, renewable subject to mutual agreement. A gratuity will be payable upon successful completion of contract.

Applicants should send two copies of cover letter and curriculum vitae, and have three academic referees sending letters of recommendation to Chair of the Search Committee, Division of Humanities, HKUST, Clear Water Bay, Kowloon, Hong Kong on or before **31 October 2009**.
